Frequently Asked Questions

1. Who can I call for lunch reservations at the Pavilion?
- Call Deity Rocamora at telephone numbers 843-9136 to 38
2. How many guests can I bring to the Bamboo Beach Club?
- Guests are welcome so long as they are accompanied by a member in good standing.
- On weekends (including Holy Week, Christmas and other Holidays to be specified by the Club) a member can bring a maximum of seven (7) guests. On weekdays a member can invite up to fourteen (14) guests.
- Guest fees are pegged at P250.00 per person. The fees are waived if you and your guests choose to have your meals at the Pavilion. Only meal charges apply.
- Members and their dependents are exempted from paying the guest fees. Dependents are the legitimate spouse of the member, and unmarried children below the age of 21. Everybody else is considered a guest.
3. Can we bring our own food and drinks to the Bamboo Beach Club?
- The Pavilion is now open to serve food and drinks. As such, the bringing of food and drinks is not allowed.
- However, if you wish to hold your own picnic, you may do so at the newly opened Mango Grove. This area was specifically built for picnics and outdoor barbecues. There are BBQ pits and tables for your use.

Get Your Stickers Now



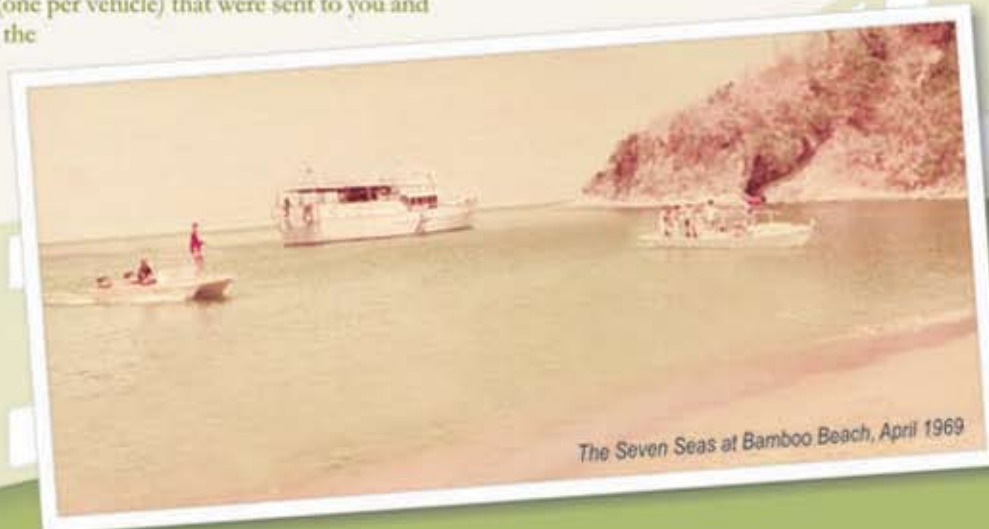
All lot owners are enjoined to get their car stickers. This will allow you smooth access to Kawayan Cove.
